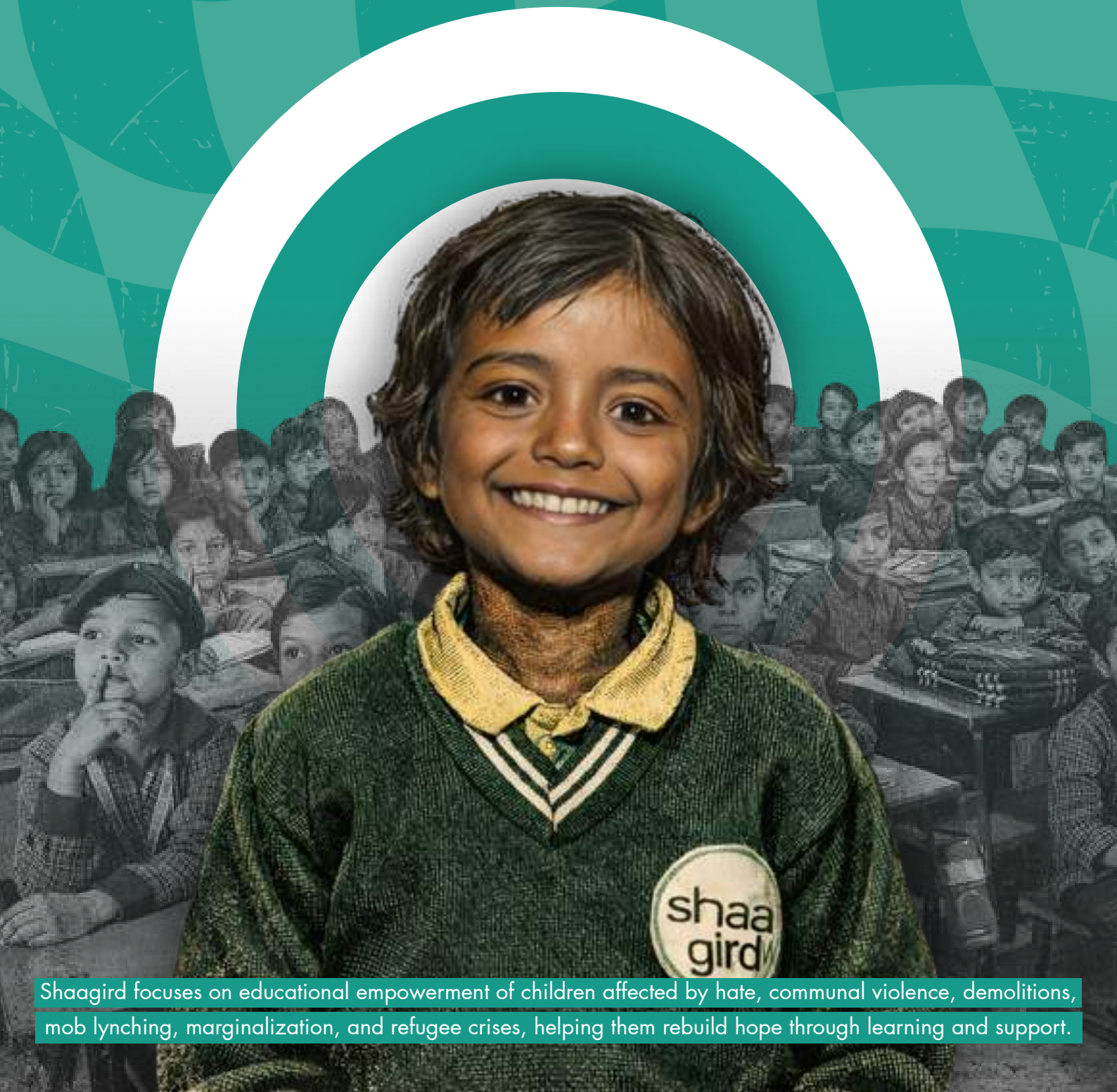

Happy May! The month of May is many a time kept at par with flourishing and growth, and so it has been in the starting week of it at Miles2Smile's Shaagird initiative. The first week of May has seen immense growth in education at Shaagird, with children of survivors of communal violence and mob lynchings stepping into the educational institute without hindrance, banking on us for a better future. At Miles2Smile, we believe in complete transparency and creating a pool of supporters where trust is the foundational pillar in order to form the future we, the pacifists, foresee. This week, your compassion reached two major categories.

1. Mob Lynching

2. Communal Violence



A) Mob Lynching

As per the available reports, in a great number of cases, mob lynching takes away the sole earners of the family. While the source of earning ends, the expenses wait for none. They continue to occur, without a pause. However, what comes to a halt is the education of children. The school fee becomes difficult to meet. But at Miles2Smile, we believe everyone deserves a quality education, regardless of life's disruptions. We're here to bridge the gap, and it is possible because of people like you, who always open their hearts and sponsor children's education. Here's a glimpse of stories learning to be rewritten through your support.



A.1) Aamir, Palla village, Haryana

On March 2, 2026, Aamir was driving his pickup truck when self-styled cow vigilantes intercepted him near Bhiwadi, ramming his vehicle to a halt. Soon, he was brutally attacked and shot in the head, dying within hours. Aamir is survived by a pregnant wife and a young daughter, too young to comprehend the loss, along with his young siblings, nephew, and aging parents. As the sole breadwinner, the responsibility of all was on his shoulders until his last breath. "How would they survive now?" is the question his family is left with. Amidst the turmoil, education of the children was compelled to be put as the lowest priority. Survival was paramount.



Intervention of Miles2Smile's Shaagird:

When the Miles2Smile learned about Aamir's lynching, the team drove its way towards Palla Village, Haryana. On reaching there, we met Aamir's aging parents, too devastated to narrate the incident; his pregnant wife, too fragile to bear the weight of it; his daughter, siblings, and nephew, too young to understand the horrific lynching. While pouring their hearts out, Aamir's family revealed the educational hindrance the children of the house will face due to the death of sole breadwinners.

The past cannot be erased, but in the future, we can try to make it better. In this attempt, we enrolled the children of Aamir's house in our educational dashboard, and with your donation, these children were able to continue their education at **Hermann Gmeiner School**.

A.2) **Roshan Khatoon, Madhubani, Bihar**

On February 25, 2026, during the month of Ramadan, Roshan Khatoon was subjected to brutal assault by a group. Khatoon was kicked, punched, and beaten, leading her to be unconscious. However, the assault did not stop; she was dragged in public and tied to a pole, and then another set of assaults was launched on her. When she could not bear the pain and asked for water while fasting, she was forced to drink a mixture of alcohol and urine, as claimed by her family. Following the assault, Khatoon was admitted to Patna Medical College, where she succumbed to her injuries on March 1st, 2026.



Intervention of Miles2Smile's Shaagird:

Khatoon already hailed from a financially fragile family, and the legal expenses of her case took a toll on her family. Miles2Smile contacted Roshan Khatoon's family to learn about the details of the case. While detailing the incident and economic fragility, the family highlighted the risk of halting the education of children, citing high school fees. Miles2Smile's Shaagird embraced the responsibility of it and, with your support, helped the children get on the educational journey.

A.3) Junaid, Ghatmeeka, Rajasthan

In February 2023, Nasir and Junaid were lynched to death on mere suspicion of cow smuggling by cow vigilantes in Rajasthan. The barbaricity of the incident started when the duo were travelling to meet a relative, and on the way were stopped by cow vigilantes who later burnt them and lynched them to death. Junaid left behind four sons, two daughters, and a grieving wife. Junaid's eldest daughter, Parwana, could not bear the weight of his father's death, fell ill, and died.



Intervention of Miles2Smile's Shaagird:

While the house was bearing the weight of two drastic deaths, the children were determined to continue their studies. Miles2Smile under Shaagird enrolled Junaid's son in a reputed school in Rajasthan in 2024 while his younger son was too young to attend school. Years passed by, Junaid's younger son became eligible for school. Miles2Smile enrolled him too in a reputed school, paving his way for a bright future.

A.4) Umardeen, Northeast Delhi, Delhi

On 17 February 2026, Rabiya Bi and her husband Umarudeen were at home, sharing snacks and talking, when their son Tehzeem called in distress. He told his father that some people had beaten him badly. The couple rushed to the spot and found Tehzeem surrounded by a crowd, badly injured and struggling. Rabiya said the attackers held his hands, pulled his hair, and beat him with whatever they found. However, what followed broke the family into fragments. When Umarudeen tried to protect his son, he was shot dead.



Intervention of Miles2Smile's Shaagird:

The family lost not only a husband and father but also their only earning member. "How will I manage now?" Rabiya cried in front of the Miles2Smile. Her pain was deep enough to bend hearts. She was left alone to take care of 3 of her daughters. To ease the weight of expenses, the Miles2Smile under Shaagird took the responsibility of her children's education, an act which provided her relief in the middle of devastation. Today, her children are ready to attain comprehensive education to create a bright future.



A.5) Guddu, Shamli, Uttar Pradesh

In June 2024, Guddu Khan, Saddam Qureshi, and Chand Miya Khan were chased for nearly 54 kilometers by alleged cow vigilantes on suspicion of cattle smuggling and subsequently brutally lynched to death. Guddu, who was the sole breadwinner of the family, left behind four young children, his wife, and elderly parents.

Guddu's four kids (then aged 10, 8, 6, and 2) lost a supportive father; his wife lost a loving husband; a mother lost a kind son; and the family lost the only source of income. Within a few months of Guddu's death, poverty crept into the family, and meeting daily expenses became difficult.



Intervention of Miles2Smile's Shaagird:

When the Shaagrid Foundation learned about Guddu's lynching, the team decided to meet the pain-stricken family. On reaching Guddu's house, the team saw his innocent children devastatedly grappling with the lynching. Due to the family's financial instability, Guddu's children's education was sacrificed until the Miles2Smile intervened and took care of the education. Today, with the support of you, dear donors, Guddu's children are able to learn English, math, science, Hindi, computer, and more at **Holy Child School**.

B.1) **Jamaluddin, Northeast Delhi, Delhi**

On the day of 24th February, 2020, Jamaluddin went to attend his niece's wedding in Farrukhabad, where he was informed about the vandalizing and ransacking of his home amidst the Delhi riots 2020. For someone like Jamaluddin, who already hailed from a humble background, a house was not just a happy dwelling but a lifelong earning. On hearing the news, he hurriedly left the wedding and made his way towards home on 27th February 2020.

However, what Jamaluddin encountered eclipsed the happiness of his entire family. He was beaten mercilessly by rioters. His body lay in blood on the road, but the blows kept coming from all sides. Five days later, Jamaludding succumbed to injuries, leaving behind four sons and his wife Nazish.



Intervention of Miles2Smile's Shaagird:

After the death of Jamaluddin, his wife Nazish took the responsibility of making ends meet. Her charpai (cot) weaving business became the only source of income, helping her meet the daily expenses of daily chores. However, the income generated from the business was not enough to pay the school fee of her four sons. While she was worried about her sons' future, Miles2Smile's Shaagird acted as a peacemaker, taking responsibility for their education. With you by our side, together, we are able to educate Jamaluddin's children, helping them create a better future.

B.2) Mursaleen, Northeast Delhi, Delhi

The 2020 Northeast Delhi violence left 53 people dead, including Mursaleen, who was the sole breadwinner of his family. He was beaten, shot in the chest, and then slashed with a sword. These injuries proved fatal, and Mursaleen lost her life. Mursaleen's body was so severely mutilated that his wife, Nargis, was unable to identify him until she recognized the thumb on his right foot.

Nargis was pregnant at the time and suddenly found herself alone with three children and no source of income. In the days that followed, the family struggled for basic necessities, often going without proper meals.



Intervention of Miles2Smile's Shaagird:

Months after Mursaleen's death, Nargis managed to meet the daily expenses of her family, but she was still grappling to educate her children, a dream which she and Mursaleen together saw. When Miles2Smile met Nargis, she demonstrated her interest in educating her children and the struggles that lay ahead on the path. The Miles2Smile under its initiative Shaagird promised her to take responsibility for her children. Today, when Nargis sees her children going to school, a sense of relief washes over her.

B.3) Faurqan, Northeast Delhi, Delhi

The month of February of 2020 hung pals of grief in Firdos's life. Her husband, Faurqan, was killed. He was one among 53 others who were killed in the Delhi riots 2020, and Firdos became one of the 53 widows of the riots.

Unaware of the riots, Furqan steps out of his house to bring snacks for their children. He was a father whose only wish was to keep his children happy. But this wish remained unfulfilled, and he never returned home. Frantic Firdoz searched for him everywhere only to find his lifeless body and mountain of responsibility, which now she alone had to bear.



Intervention of Miles2Smile's Shaagird:

Years passed by, but the wounds remained fresh, or even worse, as the financial support was crumbling. On the ground relief work during Ramadan, 2026, Miles2Smile learned about Firdos. The team went to her home to listen to her ordeal but came back with an aim: to educate her children and to create a better future for them. Today, through the Miles2Smile's Shaagird initiative, the children of Faurqan and Firdos are seeking knowledge, and seeing that gives peace to Firdos's heart.



As these children have found a place for learning, a school for a bright future, there are many other children like them waiting for an opportunity, a change, a helping hand. Through Miles2Smile's Shaagird initiative, we envision a world where every child has access to quality education. We believe education is a fundamental right, the key that unlocks a world of opportunity, regardless of background.
